

## Georgia Releases Copyright and Fair Use Guide

The University System of Georgia has developed the “Regents Guide to Understanding Copyright and Educational Fair Use.” The “Guide,” developed by the University System Committee on Copyright, provides examples of fair use and a summary of copyright law. The examples include research and writing, printed material, video and sound recordings, multimedia projects, distance education, and electronic course reserves.
