

International Education and Library Collections

On January 23-25, the University of California at Los Angeles hosted a national policy conference on two U.S. Department of Education international education programs: Title VI of the Higher Education Act and the Fulbright-Hays program. The meeting brought together a broad spectrum of representatives from higher education institutions and related organizations, who heard presentations on a variety of topics related to international education and participated in specialized focus groups. One of these break-out sessions was dedicated to "Library and Collection Development Issues" and was co-chaired by Deborah Jakubs, Head of International and Area Studies, Perkins Library, Duke University, and Director of the AAU/ARL Global Resources Program. David Magier, Director of Area Studies, Columbia University Libraries, also served as co-chair.
