

# Report of the Digital Archiving Task Force Available

The final report of the Digital Archiving Task Force is now available. At the end of 1994 the Commission on Preservation and Access and the Research Libraries Group created a Task Force on Archiving of Digital Information charged with investigating and recommending means to ensure "continued access indefinitely into the future of records stored in digital electronic form." The 21-member task force co-chaired by Donald Waters, Associate University Librarian, Yale University, and John Garrett, Chief Executive Officer of CyberVillages Corporation, recently completed their [final report](#).
