

KWIC Pics:

The California Digital Library is developing a new interface for eScholarship, an open access publishing platform with over 25,000 scholarly works. One of the most exciting features in development is Keyword in Context Pictures (a.k.a. KWIC Pics). How does it work? When a user hovers the cursor over a highlighted term in search results, KWIC Pics instantly displays a snapshot of the actual PDF page where that term appears. See KWIC Pics in action below!

monitoring of lead levels in candy should continue, current data suggests that [lead toxicity](#) from these sources is relatively low. If future analysis shows lead contamination of such food led to education and efforts to remove sources of lead in the child's environment, and no action is taken for children with blood levels less than 10 µg/dL. Studies show that the education and counseling of parents and children is effective in reducing blood-lead levels, in concert with the careful removal of
