- **RIT Digital Media Library Timeline:** Spring 2006 -> Fall 2008 Five colleges (out of eight) mandated faculty scholarship in the DML. Talking points for success...
- **Meet with a Dean, Dept. Heads– we can make your faculty's work accessible:**
 - Showcase your faculty scholarship: personal archive, departmental benefit, highlight college, & RIT - ALL LEVELS OF BENEFIT
 - Maximize research exposure & subsequent citations
 - Global exposure for potential collaborations – multidisciplinary opportunities
 - Faculty, staff, student, alumni & parent research tool
- **The Harvesting Process**
 - Harvest scholarship from arXiv, databases, homepage, or point to item OR obtain final copies from faculty (if required)
 - Use Sherpa Romeo/journals/societies/publishers for copyright permissions, request permissions from editor(s) via email
 - Metadata from faculty or RIT Libraries cataloger-generated
 - Post complete faculty scholarship document(s) OR just the metadata and upload a Sherpa Romeo document that states publisher policies
