Generic Template: Scholarly Communication Team Membership Criteria

Identify members who can represent broad subject groups from collections and/or public services perspective, e.g.

- Agriculture, Biology, & Life Sciences
- Arts & Humanities
- Health Sciences
- Physical Sciences & Engineering
- Social Sciences

In addition, look for members who possess interest / expertise, in one or more of these areas:

- Copyright & fair use
- Institutional repository development
- Intellectual property
- Licensing and journal publishing
- Project management
- Public relations / marketing
- Scholarly publishing / communication issues in general
(e.g. attended an ARL/ACRL Institute on Scholarly Communication)
- Survey / environmental scan / usability test design and delivery
