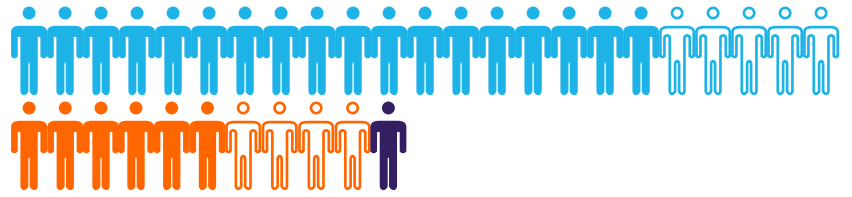

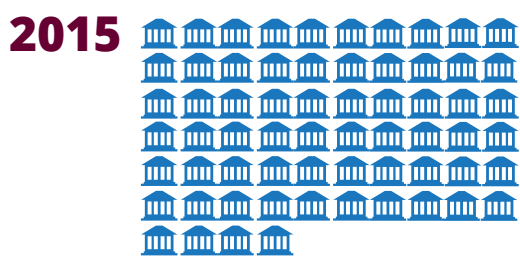

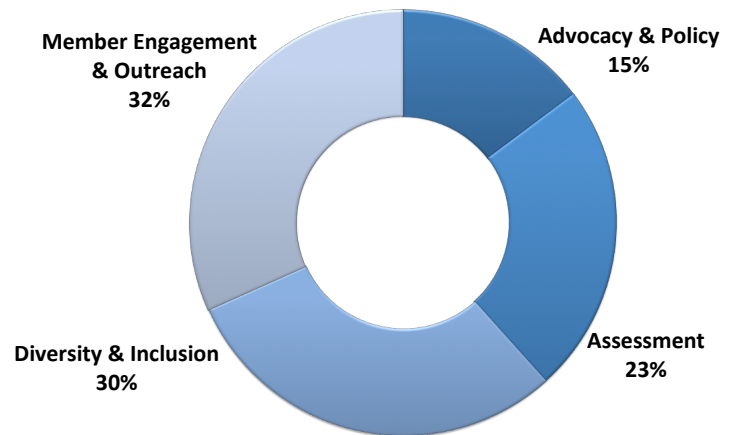

Authors Guild v. Google

Scanning books to create a searchable online library is a "fair use" of copyrighted material.



FCC Open Internet Order

No Internet "fast lanes" for those willing to pay a premium and "slow lanes" for everyone else.



USA FREEDOM Act

No bulk collection of phone records by the National Security Agency.



DMCA 1201 Rulemaking

Supports access to electronic literary works for people who are print disabled.
