



The **Advocacy and Public Policy Committee** (APC) is a standing committee that develops and oversees ARL's role in monitoring, evaluating, and influencing federal legislation, regulation, and other public policy, including international policy, that affects the research community and the development of policies and position statements that benefit all research libraries. APC develops strategic and timely communications to keep the membership informed on key issues; develops position statements that support ARL members individually and collectively; and helps members mobilize and respond to pending legislation, policies, and budgetary considerations affecting ARL, its members, and the community. APC seeks ways to partner with like-minded organizations in developing effective ways to share opinion, law, and legislation, and communicate concerns and support.
