



ARL Kaleidoscope Program Advisory Group

Purpose

The purpose of the Advisory Group is to advise and assist the senior director, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in the programming and delivery of the Kaleidoscope Program.

Charge

The Kaleidoscope Program Advisory Group reports to the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee and advises the senior director, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. The Advisory Group works with the senior director to ensure that the content and diversity scholars' experience meet the program objectives.

Membership

The Advisory Group is composed of five members including a member of the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee (DEIC), the senior director, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, and three members from the DEI community agreed to by the chair, vice-chair, and past chair of the DEIC and the executive director. The chair of the Advisory Group will be selected by the DEIC.

Terms

The Advisory Group members serve for two years, staggering membership to ensure consistency between program cohorts.

Meetings

The Advisory Group meets monthly via video conferencing platforms and otherwise as needed. The Advisory Group can, when available and appropriate, assist with the logistics of the annual Leadership Symposium.

Areas of Responsibility

The Advisory Group is responsible for:

- Advising the senior director on synchronous learning opportunities (to be held during the academic year), including identifying topics and speakers, and—as subject matter experts—facilitating the webinars,
- Planning the program for the Annual ARL Leadership Symposium, including developing topics, engaging speakers, and attending/facilitating sessions, and
- Reviewing the program evaluations by diversity scholars, speakers, and other participants, and providing feedback on the program to the senior director, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, to the DEIC, and to the executive director to shape changes for future cohorts.

Decision Making

The Advisory Group makes recommendations to the ARL senior director, Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, as appropriate to the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee, and as appropriate to the Executive Director.
