5. Provide input on the 2022 ARLies Film Festival and advice for future working groups.

Terms

Members of this working group serve between February and May 2022.

- Organization of the ARLies Film Festival event including film evaluations (virtual)
- Hosting the ARLies Film Festival event (virtual or in-person [TBD])
- Announcing the ARLies Film Festival awards (virtual)
- Evaluating the 2022 Film Festival (virtual)
